

INSTRUCTIONS FOR MANUSCRIPT PREPARATION

The proceedings of the workshop will be published by the Royal Society of Chemistry, Cambridge, UK.

Both oral and poster presentations will have the same treatment, with a four (4) pages limit, all included (text, figures, tables, references).

Please, follow STRICTLY the instructions reported and provide us (address below) with BOTH the camera ready typescript AND the relative file.

The preferred disk is a 3.5 inch IBM compatible disk, Zip disks and CD ROMS are also acceptable. The disk must be formatted correctly and a mainstream word processing package used, such as Microsoft Word or WordPerfect. The hard copies of the text MUST be identical to that on the disk, i.e. if the disk is updated the hard copy must be updated and vice versa.

Manuscripts should be received at the latest at the meeting. As we aim to publish the proceedings as soon as possible, we will appreciate earlier receiving.

Manuscripts should be written in standard English. For non mother tongue authors, please have your manuscript checked by an English-speaking person who is knowledgeable about written English and English grammar.

Please, note that manuscripts not coherent with above instructions will be returned for adjustments, thus causing an obvious publication delay.
