The final mark is given by the sum of the score of the evaluation of academic qualification and scores of the oral exam. The results will be published on the Tuscia University Website (www.unitus.it), section "Didattica>Offerta post lauream>Dottorati di Ricerca." Along with the application form, candidates shall submit a research project (max 30.000 characters, including footnotes, spaces and bibliography), which will be discussed during the oral exam. The number of characters of the project must be declared at its opening.
