

Principles of project management for research projects (4 hours, 0.5 CFU)

Lecturers: Pier Luigi Guida

Objective: This course aims to equip students with essential skills and theoretical knowledge necessary to effectively manage research projects. The seminar follows the framework of ISIPM (Italian Institute of Project Management). Students will learn to define clear objectives, plan and sequence activities, manage resources, monitor progress, and evaluate outcomes. The course will cover both quantitative and qualitative research methods, emphasizing the importance of selecting the most appropriate project management tools for different types of research. Through theoretical lessons, case studies, and practical exercises, students will gain the skills to apply project management principles in both academic and professional research contexts.
