The travel days are excluded from the mobility period. The maximum financial contribution is defined as indicated in Appendix A and is briefly summarised below: up to **€5.360,00** (based on expense receipts) for professors **from the Universidad de Cuyo (Mendoza)**; up to **€5.200,00** (based on expense receipts) for professors **from the Universidad Nacional de Córdoba or the Universidad Nacional de San Antonio de Areco**. Successful professors should individually arrange their travel, accommodation, and insurance. They are also responsible for applying for and obtaining the required visa. The financial contribution will be recognised as a total or partial reimbursement, within the limits indicated above, for all eligible costs incurred.
