

ERASMUS+ STUDY 2026/2027

Available places: 112

Allocation of places: at least 10 places are reserved for each Department; the remaining places are allocated based on University-wide merit rankings

Mobility duration: up to 5 months

Application deadline: March 20, 2026 – 11:59 PM

Who can apply

Students enrolled in **Bachelor's, Master's, Single-cycle degree programmes or PhD programmes** at the University of Tuscia in **Academic Year 2025/2026**, provided they meet:

- academic progress and GPA requirements set out in the Call;
- the maximum limit of **12 Erasmus months per study cycle** (24 months for single-cycle degrees);
- a **minimum B1 language proficiency**.

Types of mobility

- **Long mobility:** 2–5 months (between **June 1, 2026** and **July 31, 2027**)
- **Short mobility:** 5–30 days (reserved for **PhD students** and **Blended Intensive Programme – BIP** participants)

Main financial support

Erasmus+ EU grant (long mobility):

- €400/month (high cost of living countries)
- €350/month (medium/low cost of living countries)

EU top-up for students with fewer opportunities:

- €250/month

University of Tuscia additional grant (long mobility only):

- up to €350/month, based on ISEE income brackets
- minimum requirement of **12 ECTS credits**

Travel grant:

amount varies according to distance and type of travel (**green / non-green**)

Eligible activities

- courses and exams
- thesis preparation
- internship (if included in the degree programme)

All activities must be approved in the **Learning Agreement** and are fully recognised through the **ECTS system**.

How to apply

Online application via the **GOMP portal**
(one application only, no paper documents).

CHECKLIST

Basic requirements

- Enrolled at the University of Tuscia in AY 2025/2026 (Bachelor's, Master's, Single-cycle degree or PhD)
- Academic progress and GPA requirements met
- Erasmus limit not exceeded (12 months per cycle, 24 for single-cycle degrees)
- Minimum B1 language level

ISEE and financial support

- ISEE/ISEEUP for university financial aid for AY 2025/2026 obtained
- ISEE uploaded on GOMP
- ISEE uploaded by **March 20, 2026**

Important: without ISEE, no additional funding

(EU top-up for fewer opportunities and University of Tuscia grant)

- ISEE \leq €27,948.60 → student with socio-economic disadvantage
- Students more than one year beyond standard programme duration → no University top-up

Application

- One application only, submitted online via GOMP
- Destinations selected and ranked by preference
- Previous Erasmus mobility periods declared
- Language certificates / self-certification uploaded
- Application submitted by **March 20, 2026 – 11:59 PM**

Selection and acceptance

- Ranking and assigned destination checked on GOMP
- Destination accepted within **5 days**
- Refusal possible with no penalties

Before departure

- Learning Agreement completed and approved (**by April 20, 2026**)
- Erasmus Mobility Agreement signed
- Italian IBAN in the student's name provided
- OLS language test / language course completed (if required)

During mobility

- Mobility duration respected (2–5 months long / 5–30 days short)
- Activities carried out only as approved in the Learning Agreement
- Travel tickets and supporting documents kept

After mobility

- Certificate of Attendance and Transcript of Records received
- Documents and travel tickets submitted to the International Mobility Office
- EU Beneficiary Report completed
- At least **12 ECTS credits recognised** (long mobility)

Note: failure to submit the Beneficiary Report or obtain the required credits will result in **repayment of the grant.**
