## HOW DOES THE COURSE WORK?

### **Participation in ten online lectures (total 24 hours):**

**Two** of the lectures (one introductory and one final) are exclusively for Unitus students. The introductory lecture explores the main theories of equality, theoretical perspectives and key concepts of the course (e.g., non discrimination, intersectionality).

**Eight** lectures together with international lecturers and students.

In the first semester of 2024/2025, the E-lab takes place every Thursday from 5:00 PM to 7:00 PM, from October 3 to November 28, 2024, for a total of 9 sessions (18 hours). Students who regularly attend the lab and pass the final test will earn 6 ECTS credits.

In addition to the two proposing universities, the 2024/2025 edition will include the participation of: Université Paris I – Pantheon Sorbonne (Paris, France); Pepperdine University (USA); University of Illinois (USA); Nova University Lisbon (Portugal); Yaşar University (Turkey); University of Palermo (Italy); Université Libre Bruxelles (Belgium); Pontificia Universidad Católica del Perú; University of Wroclaw (Poland); University of Buenos Aires (Argentina); Università della Tuscia (Viterbo, Italy).

## **REQUIREMENTS**

- Be a student enrolled in “Law” (LMG/01) or “Security and Human Rights” (LM90)
- Have a fair knowledge of English. Please note that students without an English certificate are welcome. They will be invited to a brief online interview with the E-Lab coordinator prior to acceptance.
- Commit to participating regularly in the course
- Be interested in equality and non-discrimination law
- Engagement
