



QUICK GUIDE TO THE EXTRAORDINARY CALL ERASMUS+ TRAINEESHIP MOBILITY A.Y. 2025/2026

KEY INFORMATION

- New extended deadline: April 12, 2026 at 23:59
- Available grants: 62
- Application: via GOMP (Home > Career > International Mobility > Traineeship)
- It is possible to apply for both Erasmus Study and Traineeship (attention: mobility periods must not overlap)
- It is strictly forbidden to take exams or graduate during the Traineeship mobility

BEFORE APPLYING YOU MUST HAVE

- Letter of Acceptance completed and signed by the host organisation
- Curriculum Vitae
- Certification of language competence
- ☞ Without these documents you CANNOT apply

WHO CAN APPLY

- Students enrolled in:
 - Bachelor's Degree
 - Master's Degree
 - Single-cycle Degree☞ from the 1st year up to the 2nd year out of course
- Students enrolled in:
 - PhD programmes
 - Specialisation Schools☞ with authorization from the coordinator/director

DURATION AND PERIOD

- Minimum duration: 2 months (60 days)
- Maximum funded duration: 3 months (90 days)
- The traineeship must be completed by July 31, 2026
- Departure is possible after the publication of the ranking lists

WHERE TO CARRY OUT THE TRAINEESHIP

- In public or private organisations (companies, public bodies, NGOs, universities, research centres, etc.), only for traineeship activities (not study)
- ☞ The student must independently find the host organisation


It is possible to carry out the traineeship in:

- EU Member States
- Programme countries (Iceland, Liechtenstein, Norway, Turkey, former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia)

FINANCIAL CONTRIBUTION

- Basic contribution
 - €500/month → countries with high cost of living
 - €450/month → countries with medium/low cost of living
- **+** Possible additional contributions
 - + €444,16 one-off → for the first 30 students in the ranking
 - + €250/ month → if ISEE/ISEEUP ≤ €27,948.60
 - + additional contribution (if you obtain at least 12 CFUs):
 - a) €350/month → ISEE ≤ €27.948,60
 - b) €250/month → ISEE ≥ €27.948,61 ≤ €40.000


 **IMPORTANT:** to receive contributions based on ISEE, the ISEE/ISEEUP for a.y. 2025/2026 must be present on GOMP by the deadline of the call

 Are you an international student and your ISEE/ISEEUP has been issued but is not uploaded on GOMP? Ask the International Students Office to upload it

 Grant payment: 80% at the beginning (after the certificate of arrival); 20% at the end (after the certificate of completion of the traineeship)


HOW TO APPLY

By the deadline, you must submit your application on GOMP including:

- Letter of Acceptance (completed and signed by the host organisation)
 - Curriculum Vitae
 - Certification of language competence
-  Missing even one document → exclusion

LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS

- You must demonstrate at least B1 level (or higher)
- The document must not be older than 3 years
- You can upload one of the following:
 - official language certification ([here](#) you can find the recognised ones)
 - CLA certificate
 - language exam in your study plan (B1 if Bachelor's, B2 if Master's)
 - self-certification (only if native speaker)
 - OLS platform certificate
 - ILO platform certificate

 **SUGGESTION:** the fastest way to obtain a valid certification is to take the online placement test on the OLS (Online Linguistic Support) platform and upload that certificate
