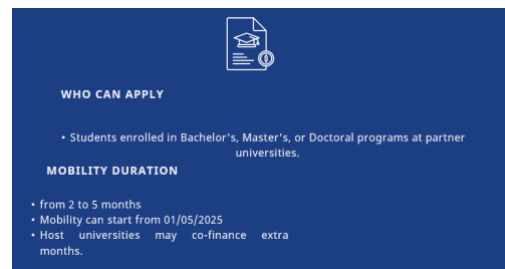


Progress note of the activities UNITUS – TNE IMPACT

Project duration: 01/10/2024 – 01/04/2026

The University of Tuscia participates as a partner in the **TNE IMPACT project**, with the aim of strengthening the University's international profile and offering new opportunities for growth for students and academic staff, contributing to the key issues of **inclusion, sustainability and innovation**.

Between March and April 2025, Unitus launched **promotion and networking** actions with several partner universities, which led to the definition of agreements with academic institutions in Morocco. At the same time, collaborations with universities in Egypt and Tunisia were strengthened, further developing existing relationships. Among the main activities, it is worth mentioning the institutional mission at the Agronomic and Veterinary Institute Hassan II in Rabat, Morocco, in which Prof. Severini and Prof. Cardarelli took part, with the aim of promoting the mobility call for students of the project, for which a presentation was produced.



On the **international mobility** front, Unitus has collected five expressions of interest from students of the Hassan II University of Rabat (Morocco), and started the selection procedures, currently in the confirmation phase. These experiences constitute an important opportunity for academic and personal growth, offering participants training courses enriched by a strong intercultural and multidisciplinary dimension.

Looking to the future, Unitus has already prepared a first state-of-the-art draft on **Double and Joint Degrees** in Mediterranean countries, with particular attention to inclusion and intercultural education. This material will be updated shortly to offer an increasingly complete picture to support academic reports. At the same time, the University is developing an in-depth questionnaire aimed at partner and associated universities, to further enrich the mapping and consolidate the basis of collaboration.

The organization of the **Staff Training Week (23-28 November 2025)**, an annual event that brings together professors, rectors and administrative staff from European and non-European universities, also continues. The initiative aims to share good practices and strengthen academic and intercultural relationships and also has a strong educational value, thanks to courses and conferences that take place daily throughout the week.

In this path, Unitus coordinates the Work Package 2 – *Curriculum Development & Double/Joint Degree Programs*, developing innovative curricula at all educational levels (BSc, MSc and PhD). Particular attention is paid to the integration of environmental, digital, intercultural and multilingual skills, thus promoting an open, inclusive educational model aligned with the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs).

Participation in TNE IMPACT represents a strategic lever for Unitus to project itself into an increasingly dynamic and competitive international context. The University intends to continue to invest in quality
