

CORRIGENDUM

Subject: Correction of scores and breakdown of qualification evaluation criteria – Ph.D. Program sheet in “Welfare, Diversity and Gender Studies” (42nd Cycle)

Candidates are hereby informed that, with reference to the Ph.D. course sheet for “Welfare, Diversity and Gender Studies” (42nd Cycle) attached to the call for applications for admission to Ph.D. programs, a correction has become necessary due to a material clerical error.

Details of the Correction

The modification concerns the total scores and the relative breakdown of individual criteria for the evaluation of qualifications for the following competition positions:

- **Position A:** 1 scholarship funded by the University;
- **Position C:** 1 position reserved for permanent employees of the Giuseppe Di Vittorio Foundation.

The aforementioned scores are now aligned with those established for the evaluation of:

- 2 positions co-funded by the University and the DIKE Department (positions B1 and B2);
- 1 position reserved for permanent employees of the National Order of Psychologists (position D);
- 2 positions funded under the WELFARE GEO-SMART AI Project – CUP J83C26000100002 (position E).

- 2 positions funded under the WELFARE GEO-SMART AI Project – CUP J83C26000100002 (position E).
